**2010-0508 and 2010-0511. Flagstar Bank, F.S.B. v. Airline Union's Mtge. Co., Slip Opinion No. 2011-Ohio-1961.**

Hamilton App. No. C-090166. Certified question answered, and judgment of the court of appeals affirmed.

Crawford App. Nos. 3-10-11, 3-10-12, and 3-10-13, 190 Ohio App.3d 581, 2010-Ohio-5672. Discretionary appeal accepted, discretionary cross-appeal not accepted, judgment of the court of appeals vacated in part, and cause remanded to the court of appeals.
