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## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

### **2010-2073. Maple Hts. City School Dist. Bd. of Edn. v. Cuyahoga Cty. Bd. of Revision.**

Board of Tax Appeals No. 2008-K-993. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of the joint motion to remand in order to implement a settlement agreement, it is ordered by the court that this case is remanded to the Board of Tax Appeals so that the board may take further action as appropriate.

### **2011-0107. In re J.V.**

Cuyahoga App. No. 94820, 2010-Ohio-5490. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County.

Upon consideration of the joint motion to supplement the record, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted.

It is further ordered that appellant's counsel shall supplement the record with transcripts from the following dates within 15 days of the date of this entry: April 6, 2005, April 28, 2005, June 15, 2005, June 17, 2005, January 5, 2007, November 20, 2008, and December 23, 2008.

### **2011-1079. Bank of Am., N.A. v. Omega Design/Build Group, L.L.C.**

Hamilton App. No. C-100018, 2011-Ohio-1650. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right from the Court of Appeals for Hamilton County.

Upon review of the notice of appeal, motion to stay the proceedings, and memorandum in support of jurisdiction, it is evident that Lawrence A. Dudek has

not filed a motion for admission pro hac vice in accordance with S.Ct.Prac.R. 1.2. Therefore, it is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that Lawrence A. Dudek is stricken from the notice of appeal, motion to stay the proceedings, and memorandum in support of jurisdiction for failure to comply with S.Ct.Prac.R. 1.2 and Gov.Bar R. XII(2)(A)(6)(a) through (e).
