### MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

# 2010-1415. S. Euclid-Lyndhurst City School Dist. Bd. of Edn. v. Cuyahoga Cty. Bd. of Revision.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2009-M-813. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of the joint motion to remand, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted, and this cause is remanded to the Board of Tax Appeals so that the board may take further action as appropriate.

#### 2011-1624. Medina v. Medina Gen. Hosp.

Cuyahoga App. No. 96171, 2011-Ohio-3990. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right.

Upon consideration of the motion for admission pro hac vice of Jerry A. Esrig for Arcelia Medina, filed by Mitchell A. Weisman, the motion fails to comply with S.Ct.Prac.R. 1.2, which requires that the motion for admission pro hac vice be filed

by the attorney who is seeking admission. Therefore, it is ordered by the court that this motion is denied.
