In re: Judicial Campaign Complaint Against Mark Davis Case No. 2011-1855

ORDER

Pursuant to Rule II(5)(D)(1) of the Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Judiciary of Ohio, the five-judge commission appointed to consider the above-cited matter met by telephone conference on November 4, 2011 to consider the report of the hearing panel of the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline filed with the Supreme Court of Ohio on November 2, 2011.

Having considered the report of the hearing panel and the record in this proceeding to date, the five-judge commission hereby issues pursuant to Rule II(5)(D)(2) an interim order that the respondent immediately and permanently cease and desist from using campaign materials that indicate the respondent has earned more than two college "degrees"; that his major or minor areas of study are separate college "degrees"; and that his Certificate in International Trade and Development is a college "degree."

The respondent shall file an affidavit with the Supreme Court of Ohio Clerk of Court before 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 7, 2011 detailing the steps he and his campaign committee have taken to comply with this order forthwith.

This interim order is issued based on the recommendation of the hearing panel.
