MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2011-1849. Smith v. Sheward.

In Prohibition. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of prohibition.

Upon consideration of relator's application for dismissal, it is ordered by the court that the application for dismissal is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

2010-2021. Disciplinary Counsel v. Squire.

On November 3, 2011, this court indefinitely suspended respondent, Percy Squire, from the practice of law. On December 5, 2011, respondent filed a joint affidavit of compliance and motion to place documents under seal. It has come to the court's attention that respondent failed to file the requisite number of copies of the motion as required by S.Ct.Prac.R. 8.5(A).

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that within ten days of the date of this entry, respondent shall refile the motion to place documents under seal along with the appropriate number of copies as provided for in S.Ct.Prac.R. 8.5(A).
