MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2011-0827. State v. Billingsley.

Portage App. Nos. 2010P0030 and 2010P0031, 2011-Ohio-1859. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Portage County.

Upon consideration of amicus curiae Ohio Public Defender's motion to participate in oral argument scheduled for Tuesday, May 8, 2012, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.

2012-0401. Gaston v. Medina Cty. Bd. of Revision.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2011-Q-1163. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of appellee's motion to dismiss, it is ordered by the court that briefing in this case is stayed and appellant shall show cause within 14 days of the date of this entry why his appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Appellant's response shall indicate whether the order appealed from constitutes a final, appealable order pursuant to *Cleveland Clinic & Southside Community Dev. Corp. v. Levin*, 116 Ohio St.3d 1209, 2007-Ohio-6665. Appellees may file a response within 10 days of the date of the filing of appellant's response to this show cause order.

Stark App. No. 2010CA00303, 2012-Ohio-897. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal.

Upon consideration of the motions for admission pro hac vice of Bradford P. Campbell and D. Alicia Hickok, it is ordered by the court that the motions are granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R.
