DISCIPLINARY CASES

2012-1107. Disciplinary Counsel v. Joseph.

Upon review of respondent's August 7, 2012 response to the order to show cause, it appears that the response did not contain a certificate of service as required by S.Ct.Prac.R. 14.2(C).

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that respondent shall file an amended response to the order to show cause that contains a certificate of service within three days of the date of this order.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2011-1946. State ex rel. Crestview Manor Nursing Home, Inc. v. Whitcomb.

Franklin App. No. 10AP-549, 2011-Ohio-5762. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Franklin County.

Upon consideration of appellant's application for dismissal, it is ordered by the court that the application for dismissal is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.

2012-0893. State ex rel. Quillen v. Marion Cty. Probate Court.

Marion App. No. 9-12-10. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Marion County.

The records of this court indicate that appellant has not filed a merit brief, due July 30, 2012, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence.

Upon consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that this cause is dismissed.

2012-1153. Billiter v. O'Farrell.

In Prohibition. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of prohibition.

Upon consideration of relator's application for dismissal, it is ordered by the court that the application for dismissal is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.
