2004-1797. Cincinnati Bar Assn. v. Lawrence.

On June 24, 2005, this court issued an order finding respondent in contempt for failing to file an affidavit of compliance as required by this court's order of January 24, 2005.

On July 30, 2012, respondent filed a motion to purge the contempt order along with an affidavit of compliance.

Upon consideration thereof, respondent's request to purge the contempt is granted.

2012-0353. Disciplinary Counsel v. Deters.

This cause came on for further consideration upon the filing of an application for reinstatement by respondent, Eric Charles Deters, Attorney Registration No. 0038050, last known business address in Independence, Kentucky.

The court coming now to consider its order of May 25, 2012, wherein the court, pursuant to Gov.Bar R. V(11)(F)(4), suspended respondent for a period of 61 days and ordered that he will not be reinstated to the practice of law in Ohio until he is reinstated to the practice of law in the state of Kentucky, finds that respondent has substantially complied with that order and with the provisions of Gov.Bar R. V(10)(A).

Therefore, it is ordered by this court that respondent is reinstated to the practice of law in the state of Ohio.

It is further ordered that the clerk of this court issue certified copies of this order as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(1), that publication be made as

provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(2), and that respondent bear the costs of publication.
