MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2012-1190. Bloodworth v. Lucas Cty. Court of Appeals.

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Upon consideration of the relator's first amended complaint filed on September 6, 2012, it is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that the first amended complaint is stricken for failure to seek leave pursuant to Civ.R. 15(A).

2012-1518. State ex rel. Taxpayers for Westerville Schools v. Franklin Cty. Bd. of Elections.

This cause is pending before the court as an original action involving an expedited election matter.

Upon consideration of the motions of the Westerville City School District Board of Education and Eugene Hollins to intervene as additional respondents, it is ordered by the court that the motions are granted and that the intervening respondents' evidence and briefs are due on the same date that respondent's evidence and brief are due.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2012-1285. David Pheils Jr. & Assoc. v. Palmer.

Lucas App. Nos. L-11-1071, L-11-1132, and L-11-1176, 2012-Ohio-2676. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right.

Upon consideration of appellant's application for dismissal, it is ordered by the court that the application for dismissal is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.
