**2011-0065. State v. McAlmont, Slip Opinion No. 2012-Ohio-4327.**

Clark App. No. 09-CA-21, 2010-Ohio-5879. Judgment affirmed.

**2011-1681. Cleveland Metro. Bar Assn. v. Davie, Slip Opinion No. 2012-Ohio-4328.**

On Final Report by the Board on the Unauthorized Practice of Law, No. UPL 09-07. Michael D. Davie and Alpha Legal Services, Inc. are enjoined from further acts constituting the unauthorized practice of law in Ohio, and a civil penalty is imposed.

### **2012-1136. State ex rel. Roberts v. Cocroft.**

In Procedendo. Upon consideration of relator's motion for leave to supplement the writ of procedendo with a supporting affidavit of operative facts, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied as moot.

### **2012-1348. State v. Brown.**

Richland App. No. 11 CA 42, 2012-Ohio-2672. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right.

Upon consideration of the motion for admission pro hac vice of Todd R. Perkins, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days of the date of this entry.
