MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2014-1321. Harper v. Tuscarawas Cty. Court of Common Pleas, Juvenile Div. In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Upon consideration of relator's motion to strike the motion to dismiss of Tuscarawas County Job and Family Services and motion to declare Henry Harper a vexatious litigator, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied as moot.

2014-0724. Columbus City Schools Bd. of Edn. v. Franklin Cty. Bd. of Revision.
