MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2014-1119. State ex rel. Niederst v. McMonagle.

In Procedendo and Prohibition. This cause came for further consideration upon the filing of intervening respondent's motion for judgment on pleadings, relator's motion to strike or, alternatively, memo opposing motion for judgment on pleadings, and intervening respondent's motion to strike relator's motion to strike. It is ordered by the court that the motions are denied as moot.

2014-1485. Brown v. Williams.

In Mandamus. This cause came for further consideration upon the filing of respondent James E. Williams's motion to strike motion to expedite, motion to suppress personal e-mail, and motion to look. It is ordered by the court that the motion is denied as moot.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

2014-1403. Trumbull Cty. Bar Assn. v. Johnson.

This cause is pending before the court upon a certification of default filed by the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline. Relator filed a motion to remand to the board on October 27, 2014. On November 3, 2014, the court remanded the matter to the board for further proceedings upon consideration of respondent's objections and brief in support.

Upon consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that relator's motion to remand is denied as moot.
