MERIT DECISIONS WITH OPINIONS

2013-1710. Ginter v. Auglaize Cty. Bd. of Revision, Slip Opinion No. 2015-Ohio-2571.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2013-Y-1782. Decision vacated and cause remanded.

MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2015-1064. State v. Jackson.

Cuyahoga App. No. 100125, 2014-Ohio-3583. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Review of appellant's memorandum in support of jurisdiction reveals that it fails to comply with S.Ct.Prac.R. 7.02(B)(1), which requires that a memorandum "shall not exceed fifteen numbered pages, exclusive of the table of contents and certificate of service." Therefore, it is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that pages 16 through 24 of the memorandum in support of jurisdiction are stricken, as they are in excess of the fifteen-page limit imposed on content for a memorandum in support of jurisdiction.

2015-1087. Gibsonburg Health, L.L.C. v. Miniet.

Sandusky App. No. S-14-023, 2015-Ohio-1863. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Review of appellant's notice of appeal and memorandum in support reveals that the filings fail to comply with S.Ct.Prac.R. 3.08, which requires that all

documents filed through the e-Filing Portal be signed. Therefore, it is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that within seven days of the date of this entry, appellant shall file an amended notice of appeal and memorandum in support that are signed in accordance with S.Ct.Prac.R. 3.08(B).

2015-0919. In Re Resignation of Lape.

On application for resignation from the practice of law of Lynn Ann Lape, Attorney Registration No. 0068728, and on report filed under seal by disciplinary counsel. Resignation accepted with disciplinary action pending.
