## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

**2015-1222. State ex rel. Cincinnati Enquirer v. Deters.**

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Upon consideration of relators' motion to compel discovery, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.

It is further ordered by the court, sua sponte, that the stay of discovery imposed on December 30, 2015, is lifted and the following amended schedule for the filing of evidence and briefs is set:

All parties shall submit their discovery responses to the requesting parties by Friday, January 22, 2016; the parties shall file any evidence by Friday, January 29, 2016; relators shall file a brief within 10 days of the filing of the evidence; respondent shall file a brief within 20 days after the filing of relators' brief; and relators may file a reply brief within 7 days after the filing of respondent's brief.

Pfeifer and O'Donnell, JJ., dissent and would not lift the stay of discovery.
