## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

#### 2016-0135. Johnson v. State.

In Procedendo. This cause came on for further consideration upon the filing of relator's "motion for judgment" and "motion for judgment pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 12.07(B)(3)." It is ordered by the court that the motions are denied as moot.

#### 2016-0423. State v. Wogenstahl.

Hamilton App. No. C-140683, 2015-Ohio-5346. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Upon review of the jurisdictional memorandum of amici curiae, National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers and the Innocence Network, in support of appellant, it is evident that Seth Miller and Amelia R.V. Maxfield have not filed timely motions for admission pro hac vice pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 2.02. Therefore, it is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that Seth Miller and Amelia R.V. Maxfield are stricken from the jurisdictional memorandum of amici curiae, National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers and the Innocence Network, for failure to comply with S.Ct.Prac.R. 2.02.

#### 2016-0605. State ex rel. Royster v. Ohio Adult Parole Auth.

Franklin App. No. 15AP-863, 2016-Ohio-953. This cause was filed as a jurisdictional appeal. Upon consideration of appellant's memorandum in support of jurisdiction, it is determined by the court that this cause originated in the court of appeals and, therefore, should proceed as an appeal of right pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 5.01.

The clerk shall issue an order for the transmittal of the record from the Court of Appeals for Franklin County, and the parties shall brief this case in accordance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio.
