{¶ 2} The court coming now to consider its order of August 28, 2013, wherein the court, pursuant to Gov.Bar R. V(12)(A)(3), suspended respondent from the practice of law for a period of one year with six months stayed on condition, and its order of September 16, 2015, wherein the court, pursuant to Gov.Bar R.
