MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2015-2006. Joseph Giordano Sr. Revocable Trust v. Cuyahoga Cty. Bd. of Revision.

Board of Tax Appeals, Nos. 2014-4636, 2014-4637, and 2014-4788. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of the joint motion to remand the appeal to the Board of Tax Appeals in order to implement a settlement, it is ordered by the court that the cause is remanded to the Board of Tax Appeals to take further action as appropriate.

It is further ordered that a mandate be sent to and filed with the Board of Tax Appeals.

2016-0784. Boddie v. Landers.

Franklin App. No. 15AP-962. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Review of appellant's memorandum in support of jurisdiction reveals that it fails to comply with S.Ct.Prac.R. 7.02(B)(1), which requires that a memorandum "shall not exceed fifteen numbered pages, exclusive of the table of contents and certificate of service." Therefore, it is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that pages 19 through 36 of the memorandum in support of jurisdiction are stricken, as they are in excess of the 15-page limit imposed on content for a memorandum in support of jurisdiction.
