MERIT DECISIONS WITHOUT OPINIONS

2016-0384. State ex rel. Fort v. Mason.

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Upon consideration of respondents' motion to dismiss, it is ordered by the court that the motion to dismiss is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.

O'Donnell, Lanzinger, Kennedy, and French, JJ., concur.

O'Connor, C.J., and Pfeifer and O'Neill, JJ., dissent, and would grant an alternative writ.

MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2016-0448. State ex rel. Carlton v. Haas.

In Prohibition. This cause came on for further consideration upon the filing of relator's motion to apply "one document rule" and motion to consolidate with case No. 2016-0530 and take judicial notice. It is ordered by the court that the motions are denied as moot.

2016-0760. CitiMortgage, Inc. v. Hasan.

Cuyahoga App. No. 103248, 2016-Ohio-1544. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Upon consideration of appellant's motion for stay of court of appeals' judgment, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.

RECONSIDERATION OF PRIOR DECISIONS

2016-0226. State v. James.

Cuyahoga App. No. 102604, 2015-Ohio-4987. This cause came on for further consideration upon the filing of appellant's motion for reconsideration. It is ordered by the court that the motion is granted.

It further ordered by the court that the clerk's office shall immediately file appellant's memorandum in support of jurisdiction that is attached to the motion for reconsideration. Appellee may file a memorandum in response to jurisdiction within 30 days of the date of this entry.
