MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

In re Harris.

On April 20, 2016, this court found Dwayne Harris to be a vexatious litigator under S.Ct.Prac.R. 4.03(B). This court further ordered that Harris was prohibited from continuing or instituting legal proceedings in the court without obtaining leave. On August 8, 2016, Harris presented an application for leave to institute a legal proceeding in the Ohio Supreme Court.

It is ordered by the court that the application for leave is denied.

2015-0575. New York Frozen Foods, Inc. v. Bedford Hts. Income Tax Bd. of Rev.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2012-55. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of the joint motion of appellees/cross-appellants and amicus curiae, Regional Income Tax Agency, for leave of court for divided argument time scheduled for Wednesday, August 17, 2016, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. Amicus curiae shall share the time allotted to appellees/cross-appellants.

2016-0788. Hooks v. Turner.

Ross App. No. 15CA3477, 2016-Ohio-3083. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Ross County.

Upon consideration of appellee's motion for appointment of counsel, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted and the Ohio Public Defender's Office is appointed to represent appellee.

2016-0973. Disciplinary Counsel v. Dickinson.

On certified order of the Supreme Court of California, case No. S231746. Steven Lee Dickinson, Attorney Registration No. 0025415, is hereby suspended from the practice of law in Ohio for two years with 22 months stayed.
