MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2015-2092. State ex rel. Cornerstone Developers, Ltd. v. Greene Cty. Bd. of Elections.

Miscellaneous case. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for writs of mandamus and prohibition involving an expedited election case.

Upon consideration of relator's emergency motion for leave to file supplemental verified complaint for writ of mandamus and/or prohibition instante, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. The supplemental complaint attached to relator's emergency motion is deemed filed, and respondents are not required to file an answer to the supplemental complaint. The briefing schedule in this case remains unaltered by the granting of the emergency motion, and the parties shall address any additional issues raised by the supplemental complaint in their merit briefs.
