AFFIDAVITS OF DISQUALIFICATION

The chief justice has released the following judicial-disqualification opinions, which were previously issued as entries in response to affidavits of disqualification filed pursuant to R.C. 2501.13 and 2701.03, respectively.

MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2016-1560. Centerville City Schools Bd. of Edn. v. Montgomery Cty. Bd. of Revision.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2015-2364. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals. The records of this court indicate that appellant has not filed a merit brief, due January 23, 2017, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence.
