2011-1017. Disciplinary Counsel v. Hall.

On January 9, 2017, respondent, Eric Dorman Hall, filed an application to terminate probation. Upon consideration thereof, the court finds that respondent has substantially complied with Gov.Bar R. V(21)(D) and with its order, dated September 24, 2015, in which the court reinstated respondent to the practice of law and placed him on monitored probation for a period of one year.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by this court that the probation of respondent, Eric Dorman Hall, Attorney Registration No. 0067566, last known business address in Medina, Ohio, is terminated.

It is further ordered that the clerk of this court issue certified copies of this order as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(17)(D)(1) and that publication be made as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(17)(D)(2).
