## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

**2016-1530. Dublin City Schools Bd. of Edn. v. Franklin Cty. Bd. of Revision.**

Board of Tax Appeals, Nos. 2015-1919 and 2015-1920. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of the joint motion to remand to the Franklin County Board of Revision to implement a settlement, it is ordered by the court that the cause is remanded to the Franklin County Board of Revision to take further action as appropriate.

It is further ordered that mandates be sent to and filed with the Board of Tax Appeals and the Franklin County Board of Revision.

**2016-1907. In re Apparent Violation & Intent to Assess Forfeiture of Wylie.**

Public Utilities Commission, No. 15-2029-TR-CVF. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

Upon consideration of appellee's motion to suspend briefing schedule, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted and the briefing schedule is stayed pending the court's resolution of appellee's motion to dismiss and appellant's motion to transfer appeal.

## MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

**2016-1881. State ex rel. Moore v. Reinbold.**

Cuyahoga App. No. 104903, 2016-Ohio-7787. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County.

Upon consideration of appellant's application for dismissal, it is ordered by the court that the application for dismissal is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.

It is further ordered that a mandate be sent to and filed with the clerk of the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County.

**2016-1905. Moore v. Reinbold.**

In Procedendo. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of procedendo.

Upon consideration of relator's application for dismissal, it is ordered by the court that the application for dismissal is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.
