MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

1994-2622. State v. Otte.

Cuyahoga App. No. 64617. Pursuant to a warrant of reprieve issued by the governor and filed with this court on May 1, 2017, it was ordered that Gary Otte's sentence be carried into execution on Wednesday, September 13, 2017. In order to facilitate this court's timely consideration of any matters relating to the execution of appellant's sentence, it is ordered by the court that the chief justice may suspend application of any provisions of the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court, including but not limited to the filing requirements imposed by S.Ct.Prac.R. 3.02.

Service of documents as required by S.Ct.Prac.R. 3.11 shall be personal, by facsimile transmission, or by e-mail.

Counsel of record for the parties shall provide this court with a copy of any document relating to this matter that is filed in or issued by any other court in this state or any federal court, as well as any commutation, pardon, or warrant of reprieve issued by the governor. A copy of the document shall be delivered to the office of the clerk as soon as possible, either personally, by facsimile transmission, or by e-mail.

Cuyahoga App. No. 103918, 2016-Ohio-1549. On appellant's motion for status of case or to advance to judgment. Motion denied as moot.

2016-1815. ARCP LS Bedford Hts. OH, L.L.C. v. Cuyahoga Cty. Bd. of Revision.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2015-2145. On joint motion to remand to implement settlement. Motion granted. Cause remanded to the Board of Tax Appeals to take further action as appropriate.

2017-0780. State ex rel. Armatas v. Plain Twp. Bd. of Trustees.

Stark App. No. 2016CA00188, 2017-Ohio-2645. Appellant has not filed a merit brief, due August 8, 2017, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.

In Procedendo. On relator's application for dismissal. Application granted. Cause dismissed.
