## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

**2019-0295. *Bey v. Rasawehr.***

Mercer App. Nos. 10-18-02 and 10-18-03, 2019-Ohio-57. On motion of amici curiae Electronic Frontier Foundation et al. for leave to split oral-argument time with appellant. Motion granted. Amici curiae shall share the time allotted to appellant.

**2019-1623. *State v. DeVore.***

Ashland App. No. 19-COA-017, 2019-Ohio-4035. On appellant's motion pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 3.11(E)(2). Motion denied as moot.

**2019-1693. *Griffith v. Chelsea Condominium.***

Cuyahoga App. No. 108988. On appellants' motion for leave to file memorandum in support of jurisdiction under seal. Motion granted.

**2019-1772. *State ex rel. Neguse v. Crawford.***

Franklin App. No. 18AP-526, 2019-Ohio-4950. On appellant's memorandum in support of jurisdiction. This cause originated in the court of appeals and should proceed as an appeal of right pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 5.01. The clerk shall issue an order for the transmission of the record from the Court of Appeals for Franklin County, and the parties shall otherwise proceed in accordance with S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.02 through 16.07.
