MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2019-0898. Cincinnati v. Fourth Natl. Realty, L.L.C.

Hamilton App. Nos. C-180156 and C-180174, 2019-Ohio-1868. Ohio Attorney General ordered to file an amicus brief within 30 days. Any party may respond to the Ohio Attorney General's amicus brief within 15 days after it has been filed.

2020-0423. Ohio State Bar Assn. v. Timberwolf Litigation & Research Servs., L.L.C.

On motion to quash subpoena duces tecum on constitutional grounds filed by respondent, Timberwolf Litigation and Research Services, L.L.C. Respondent's motion denied as untimely. Motion of relator, Ohio State Bar Association, to show cause why respondent should not be held in contempt granted. Respondent found in contempt. James Houk, statutory agent for respondent, may purge contempt by producing all records requested in the subpoena in respondent's possession, custody, or control within 45 days. If the contempt is not purged within 45 days, respondent shall be fined \$50 per day up to the \$250 maximum authorized by statute.
