This case was tried to a magistrate of the court. On November 6, 2001, the magistrate issued a decision recommending judgment for defendant.

Civ.R. 53 states: "Within fourteen days of the filing of a magistrate's decision, a party may file written objections to the magistrate's decision." Plaintiff timely filed his objections to the decision.

Upon review of the record, the magistrate's decision, and the objections, the court finds that the magistrate correctly analyzed the issues and applied the law to the facts. Therefore, the objections are OVERRULED and the court adopts the magistrate's decision and recommendation as its own. Judgment is rendered in favor of defendant. Court costs are assessed against plaintiff. The clerk shall serve upon all parties notice of this judgment and its date of entry upon the journal.

Additionally, plaintiff's November 13, 2001, motion for findings of fact and conclusions of law is OVERRULED.
