- $\{\P5\}$ 1) I find, by a preponderance of the evidence, negligence by defendant has been shown. Baisden v. Southern Ohio

Correctional Facility (1977), 76-0617-AD; Stewart v. Ohio National Guard (1979), 78-0342-AD;

- $\{\P6\}$ 2) Plaintiff has suffered damages in the amount of \$159.50, plus the \$25.00 filing fee, which may be reimbursed as compensable damages pursuant to the holding in *Bailey v. Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction* (1990), 62 Ohio Misc. 2d 19.
- $\{\P7\}$ Having considered all the evidence in the claim file and adopting the memorandum decision concurrently herewith;
 - $\{\P8\}$ IT IS ORDERED THAT:
- $\{\P9\}$ 1) Plaintiff's claim is GRANTED and judgment is rendered in favor of the plaintiff;
- $\{\P 10\}$ 2) Defendant (Cleveland State University) pay plaintiff (Qiang Zhang) \$184.50 and such interest as is allowed by law;
 - $\{\P11\}$ 3) Court costs are assessed against defendant.
