The notice required plaintiff to file a complaint form providing a complete mailing address for defendant. The notice, in pertinent part, stated: "The completed complaint must be filed in this court before October 11, 2002. If the completed complaint is not returned to this office before the above date, your complaint will be dismissed.";

**{¶4}** 3) A check of the docket reveals plaintiff has not submitted the completed form complaint.

{¶5} IT IS ORDERED THAT:

{¶6} 1) Plaintiff's case is DISMISSED without prejudice;

{¶7} 2) The court shall absorb the court costs of this case.
