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THE COURT FINDS THAT:

{¶1} On April 18, 2002, plaintiff, Philip A. Mesi, filed a complaint against defendant, The Supreme Court of Ohio. Plaintiff alleges he paid an attorney registration fee of \$250.00 in error when he was in fact granted retirement status which requires no registration fee. Plaintiff prays for the return of the \$250.00 registration fee;
