- {¶1} Plaintiff brought this action against defendant on an account for breach of contract and unjust enrichment. The case is premised upon defendant's failure to remit payment for a shipment of paper supplies delivered in accordance with the parties' October 16, 2001, agreement. Defendant denied liability on the grounds that the delivered product failed to conform to the terms of the agreement.
- $\{\P2\}$ The case was tried to the court on February 10, 2003. At the close of the proceedings, the court rendered judgment in favor of plaintiff in an amount equal to the contract price of \$17,924, plus interest at a rate of 10% per annum beginning 30 days from the date of plaintiff's November 12, 2001, invoice. The court further held that any non-conformity of the delivered product was attributable to defendant's failure to provide clear specifications.

{¶3} Accordingly, judgment is hereby entered in favor of plaintiff in the amount of \$20,148.95, which represents \$17,924, plus 10% interest from the date of December 13, 2001, and the \$25 filing fee paid by plaintiff. Court costs are assessed against defendant. The clerk shall serve upon all parties notice of this judgment and its date of entry upon the journal.
