{¶1} THE COURT FINDS THAT:

**{¶2}** 1) On January 8, 2003, plaintiff, Larry H. Shelley, filed a complaint but failed to name a defendant;

{¶3} 2) On January 9, 2003, this court issued a return of complaint form/direction to complete form notice. The notice required plaintiff to file a complaint form naming a state entity as defendant. The notice, in pertinent part, stated: "The completed complaint must be filed in this court before February 6, 2003. If the completed complaint is not returned to this office before the above date, your complaint will be dismissed.";

**{¶4}** 3) A check of the docket reveals plaintiff has not submitted the completed form complaint.
