{¶1} THE COURT FINDS THAT:

{¶2} 1) On November 12, 2002, plaintiff, Verne Taylor, filed a complaint but failed to name a proper defendant;

{¶3} 2) On November 14, 2002, this court issued a pre-screening entry (Jr. Vol. 725, Pg. 35) dismissing Tradewinds Marketing LLC as a party and requiring plaintiff to file a complaint form naming a state entity as defendant. The entry, in pertinent part, stated: "The completed complaint must be filed in this court before December 11, 2002. If the completed complaint is not returned to this office before the above date, your complaint will be dismissed.";

{¶4} 3) A check of the docket reveals plaintiff has not submitted the completed form complaint.

{¶5} IT IS ORDERED THAT:

{¶6} 1) Plaintiff's case is DISMISSED without prejudice;

{¶7} 2) The court shall absorb the court costs of this case.
