



plaintiffs' injuries<sup>1</sup> on March 18, 1996. However, the court further finds that plaintiff's, Timothy Humberson, negligent driving was also a proximate cause of plaintiffs' injuries. Accordingly, judgment is rendered in favor of plaintiffs in an amount to be determined after the damages phase of the trial. Any compensatory damages recoverable by plaintiffs shall be reduced by 45 percent, to account for Timothy Humberson's contributory negligence. The court shall issue an entry in the near future scheduling a date for the trial on the issue of damages.
