

{¶4} Upon review, CSEA's motion to intervene is DENIED. Plaintiff's motion to strike is DENIED as moot. Accordingly, the magistrate's decision is now ripe for review.

{¶5} Upon review of the record and the magistrate's decision, the court determines that there is no error of law or other defect on the face of the magistrate's decision. Therefore, the court adopts the magistrate's decision and recommendation as its own including the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein. In accordance with the magistrate's decision, judgment is rendered in favor of plaintiff in the total amount of \$8,500 which includes the filing fee paid by plaintiff. Court costs are assessed against defendant. The clerk shall serve upon all parties notice of this judgment and its date of entry upon the journal.
