## {¶1} THE COURT FINDS THAT:

- {¶2} 1) On January 27, 2004, plaintiff, Christ Steimle, filed a complaint against defendant, Warren Correctional Institution, alleging his photographs were lost by defendant's personnel. Plaintiff seeks damages in the amount of \$17.00, the estimated value of the photographs, plus \$25.00 for filing fee reimbursement. Plaintiff submitted the filing fee with his complaint;

- {¶5} 1) I find, by a preponderance of the evidence, negligence by defendant has been shown. *Baisden v. Southern Ohio Correctional Facility* (1977), 76-0617-AD; *Stewart v. Ohio National Guard* (1979), 78-0342-AD;
- $\{\P 6\}$  2) Plaintiff has suffered damages in the amount of \$15.00, plus the \$25.00 filing fee, which may be reimbursed as compensable damages pursuant to the holding in *Bailey v. Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction* (1990), 62 Ohio Misc.

2d 19.
