- {¶6} 2) Plaintiff has suffered damages in the amount of \$67.85, plus the \$25.00 filing fee, which may be reimbursed as compensable damages pursuant to the holding in *Bailey v. Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction* (1990), 62 Ohio Misc. 2d 19.

{¶7} Having considered all the evidence in the claim file and, for the reasons set forth in the memorandum decision filed concurrently herewith, judgment is rendered in favor of plaintiff in the amount of \$92.85, which includes the filing fee. Court costs shall be absorbed. The clerk shall serve upon all parties notice of this judgment and its date of entry upon the journal.
