{¶ 1} The applicant filed a reparations application seeking reimbursement of expenses incurred with respect to an alleged May 13, 2003 sexual assault incident. On June 1, 2004, the Attorney General denied the applicant’s claim pursuant to R.C. 2743.52(A) contending that the applicant failed to prove she was a victim of criminally injurious conduct. The Attorney General also denied the claim pursuant to R.C. 2743.60(A) asserting that the applicant failed to report the alleged incident to law enforcement authorities. On June 8, 2004, the applicant filed a request for reconsideration. On July 2, 2004, the Attorney General denied the claim once again. On July 12, 2004, the applicant filed a notice of appeal to the Attorney General’s July 2, 2004 Final Decision. Hence, this appeal came to be heard before this panel of three commissioners on December 1, 2004 at 1:20 P.M.

{¶ 2} Neither the applicant nor anyone on her behalf appeared at the hearing. An Assistant Attorney General attended the hearing and stated that she rests on the documents contained in the file.

{¶ 3} From review of the file and with full and careful consideration given to all the information presented at the hearing, we find that the July 2, 2004 decision of the Attorney General shall be affirmed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT

{¶ 4} “1)The July 2, 2004 decision of the Attorney General is AFFIRMED;

{¶ 5} “2)This claim is DENIED and judgment is entered for the state of Ohio;

{¶ 6} “3) Costs are assumed by the court of claims victims of crime fund.
