- {¶ 3} Upon review of the motion for summary judgment and the evidentiary materials submitted therewith, and construing the evidence in favor of plaintiff, the court finds that the only reasonable conclusions to be drawn from the evidence is that defendant owed no duty to plaintiff with respect to the maintenance of the culvert in question. Consequently, defendant is entitled to judgment as a matter of law and the motion for summary judgment is hereby GRANTED. Court costs are assessed against plaintiff. The clerk shall serve upon all parties notice of this judgment and its date of entry upon the journal.
