MEMORANDUM DECISION

FINDINGS OF FACT

- **{¶1}** 1) On December 8, 2006, plaintiff, Gayla Brent, suffered personal injury when she entered a state owned van parked on the premises of defendant, Quail Hollow State Park. Specifically, plaintiff struck her head against a mounted gun rack inside the state owned van causing a laceration.
- **{¶2}** 2) Plaintiff implied her head injury was proximately caused by negligence on the part of defendant in maintaining a dangerous condition inside the van. Consequently, plaintiff filed this complaint seeking to recover \$261.80, the cost of unreimbursed medical expenses resulting from the December 8, 2006, personal injury incident. The \$25.00 filing fee was paid and reimbursement of that amount was requested.
- **{¶3}** 3) Defendant filed an investigation report noting, "[d]efendant does not dispute [p]laintiff's claim."

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- **{¶4}** 1) Sufficient proof of liability on the part of defendant has been shown. *Cisco v. Ohio Veterans Home*, 2003-Ohio-1122, 2002-08394-AD; *Stoneking v. Cleveland State University* (2006), 2006-03290-AD.
- **{¶5}** 2) Plaintiff has suffered damages in the amount of \$261.80. The \$25.00 filling fee may be reimbursed as compensable costs pursuant to R.C. 2335.19. See *Bailey v. Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction* (1990), 62 Ohio Misc. 2d 19, 587 N.E. 2d 990.
