ORDER OF A THREE-
COMMISSIONER PANEL

{¶1} THE COURT FINDS THAT

{¶2} 1) On January 9, 2007, the applicant filed a compensation application seeking reimbursement of expenses incurred with respect to a series of alleged criminal incidents occurring between 1985 and 1992;

{¶3} 2) On January 29, 2007, the Attorney General denied the claim pursuant to R.C. 2743.56(B) and R.C. 2743.60(A) because the applicant failed to file a reparations application within two years of the alleged incidents of criminally injurious conduct;

{¶4} 3) On February 9, 2007, the applicant filed a request for reconsideration;

{¶5} 4) On March 8, 2007, the Attorney General issued a Final Decision denying the claim once again;

{¶6} 5) On March 12, 2007, the applicant filed a notice of appeal to the Attorney General's March 8, 2007 Final Decision;

{¶7} 6) On June 15, 2007, the court issued an order rescheduling the matter for oral hearing to August 9, 2007 at 9:30 A.M.;

{¶8} 7) On August 9, 2007, a hearing was convened. At the beginning of the hearing, the applicant's attorney moved to dismiss the appeal. The Attorney General raised no objection to the motion.

{¶9} IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT

{¶10} 1) The March 12, 2007 notice of appeal is hereby DISMISSED without prejudice;

{¶11} 2) Costs are assumed by the court of claims victims of crime fund.
