## JUDGMENT ENTRY

{¶ 1} On March 10, 2008, the magistrate issued a decision recommending judgment for plaintiff in the amount of \$6,195.

{¶ 2} Civ.R. 53(D)(3)(b)(i) states, in part: “A party may file written objections to a magistrate’s decision within fourteen days of the filing of the decision, whether or not the court has adopted the decision during that fourteen-day period as permitted by Civ.R. 53(D)(4)(e)(i).” Defendant timely filed an objection concerning the magistrate’s reliance on replacement value as a measure of damages in determining the value of plaintiff’s personal property.

{¶ 3} Upon review of the record, the magistrate’s decision and the objection, the court finds that the magistrate has properly determined the factual issues and appropriately applied the law. Therefore, the objection is **OVERRULED** and the court adopts the magistrate’s decision and recommendation as its own, including findings of
