{¶ 1} Dewayne Goins entered a plea of guilty to aggravated burglary and two

counts of aggravated robbery. He was sentenced to a total of ten years incarceration. Goins filed a notice of appeal and, in due course, his appointed appellate counsel filed an *Anders* brief, concluding that there were no meritorious issues for appeal.

{¶ 1} On June 2, 2004, we informed Goins of the fact that his counsel had filed an *Anders* brief and granted him sixty days from that date to file his pro se brief, if any.

{¶ 2} No such pro se brief has been filed.

{¶ 3} We have thoroughly examined the record of the proceedings in this case, and we agree with the assessment of appellate counsel that there are no meritorious issues for appellate review.

{¶ 4} The judgment appealed from will be affirmed.
