{¶1} This appeal came to be heard before this panel of three commissioners on August 7, 2003 at 11:10 A.M. upon the applicant’s April 16, 2003 appeal from the March 17, 2003 Final Decision of the Attorney General.

{¶2} On supplemental, the Attorney General denied the applicant’s claim for additional reimbursement pursuant to R.C. 2743.60(E) since the applicant was convicted of theft, a fifth degree felony, on October 24, 2002. The applicant appealed the Attorney General’s Final Decision.

{¶3} Neither the applicant nor anyone on his behalf appeared at the hearing. An Assistant Attorney General attended the hearing and stated that she rests on her Brief pending any questions from the panel.

{¶4} From review of the file and with full and careful consideration given to all the information presented at the hearing, we find the March 17, 2003 decision of the Attorney General shall be affirmed.
