- {¶ 1} Relator requests that this court compel respondent judge to grant him jail-time credit in *State v. Ward*, Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas Case No. CR-497192.
- {¶2} Respondent has filed a motion for summary judgment, attached to which is a copy of a journal entry issued by respondent and received for filing by the clerk on November 19, 2010, in which respondent granted relator 26 days jail-time credit.
