Appointed as a magistrate or judge between July 1 – December 31 of first year of the biennial compliance period	36 hours, including 10 hour of instruction offered by the Judicial College, of which 3 hours judicial conduct instruction must be completed.
Appointed as a magistrate or judge between January 1 – June 30 of the second year of the biennial compliance period	32 hours, 10 hours of instruction offered by the Judicial College, of which 3 hours judicial conduct instruction must be completed.
Appointed as a magistrate or judge between July 1 – December 31 of the second year of the biennial compliance period	24 hour CLE requirement, including 2.50 hours of attorney professional conduct. Hours are prorated to the attorney CLE requirement.
