Ethical Issues Related to Judicial Family Life, Part II (10:50 a.m.)

The Code of Judicial Conduct applies exclusively to judges and lawyers authorized to perform judicial functions in a court. Although not subject to the provisions of the Code, members of a judge's family, particularly a judge's spouse or partner, should be familiar with the Code to facilitate the judge's compliance and avoid unnecessary and potentially embarrassing missteps.
