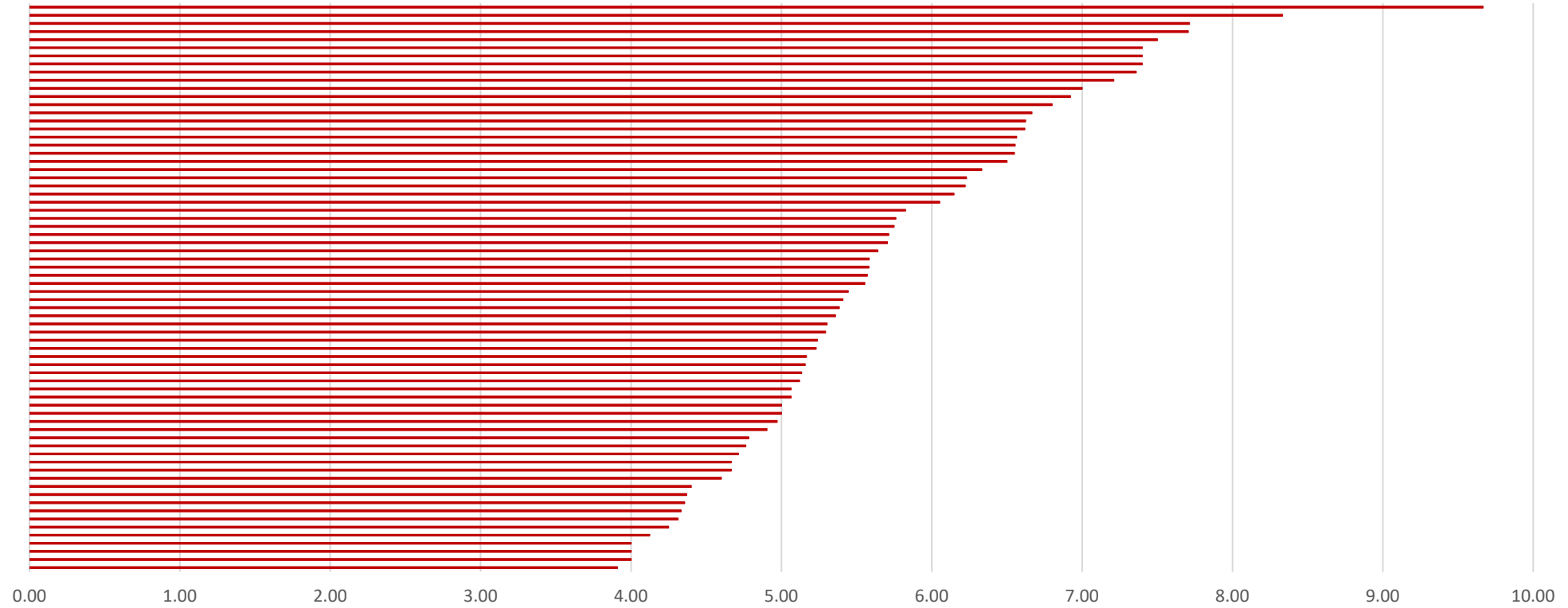

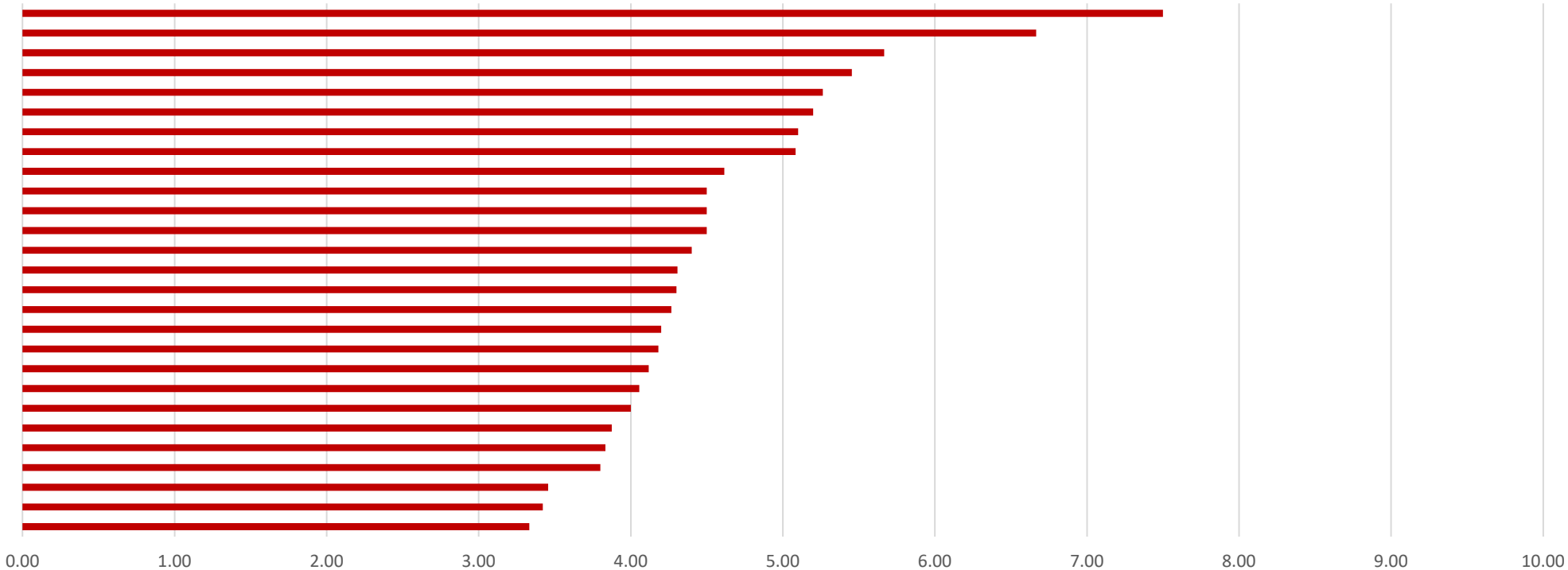

Average Terms Imposed (in years) for Single-Offense, Single-Count F1 Commitments by County, 2010-2019*



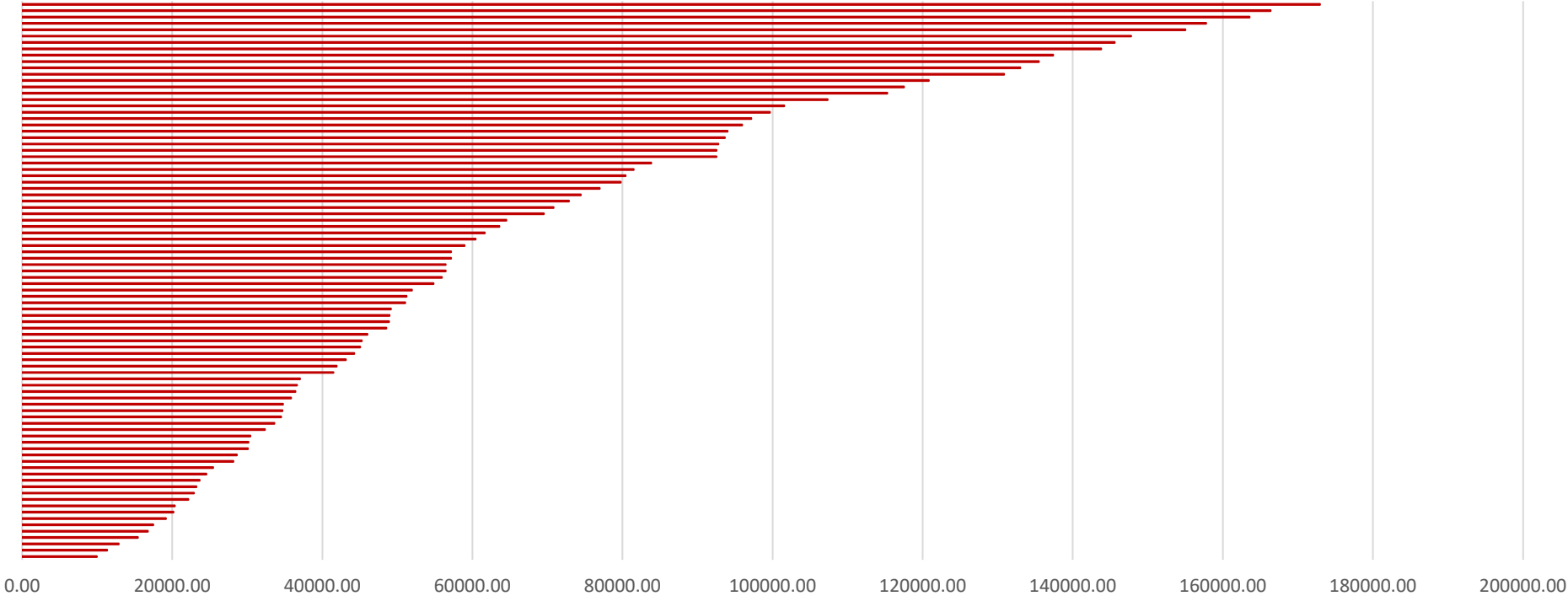
*Excludes counties with fewer than 5 applicable commitments and cases with gun spec time and prior DRC commitments.

Average Terms Imposed (in years) for Single-Offense, Single-Count F1 Agg Robbery Commitments by County, 2010-2019*



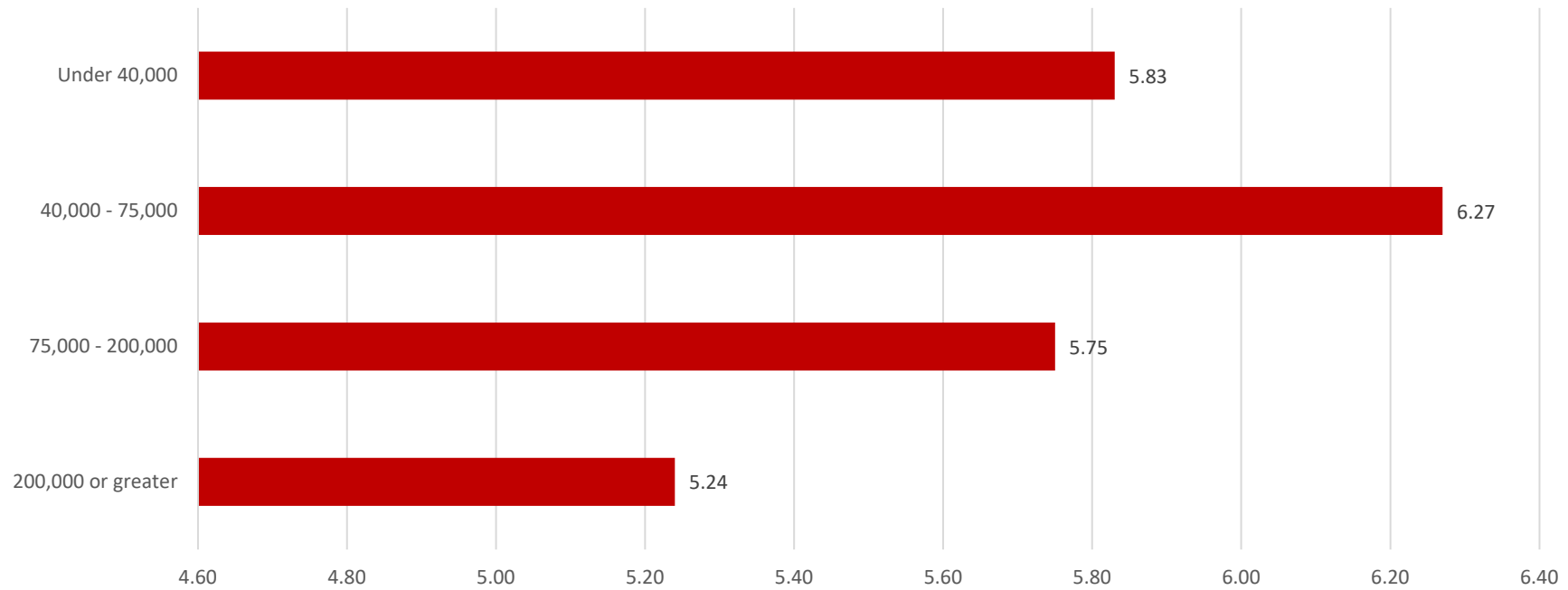

Average Aggregate Term Imposed (in years) among F1 Commitments, by Size of County, 2010-2019*



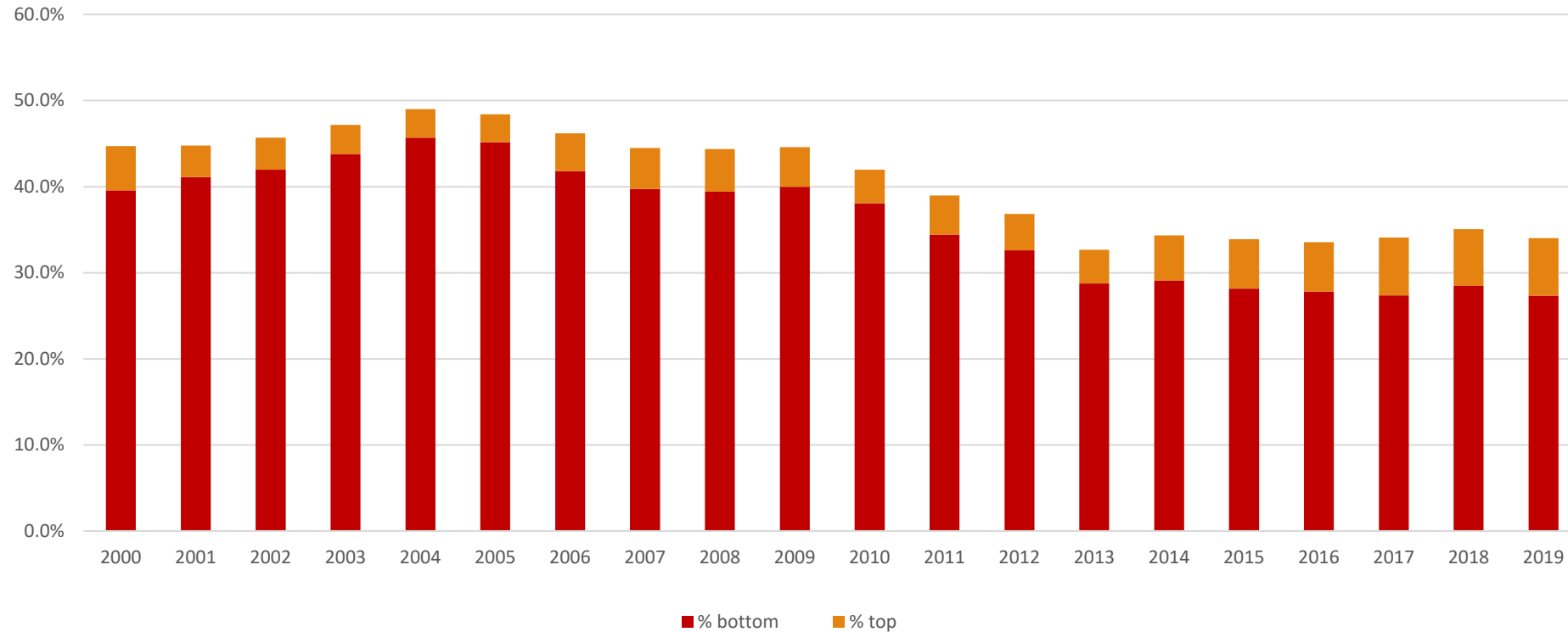
*Post SB2 F1 commitments, excluding gun spec and enhancement time and commitments with time imposed consecutively across counts or offenses. Differences in means are statistically significant.

State v. Foster (2006) severed three provisions from S.B. 2 that addressed prison sentence lengths:

- **Minimum on First Commitment to Prison** – encouraged minimum term from basic range
- **Reserve the Maximum** – impose maximum only for worst offenders
- **Consecutive Sentences** – give reasons for imposing consecutive sentences; however, H.B. 86 reenacted language requiring findings, consistent with *State v. Hodge* (2010)

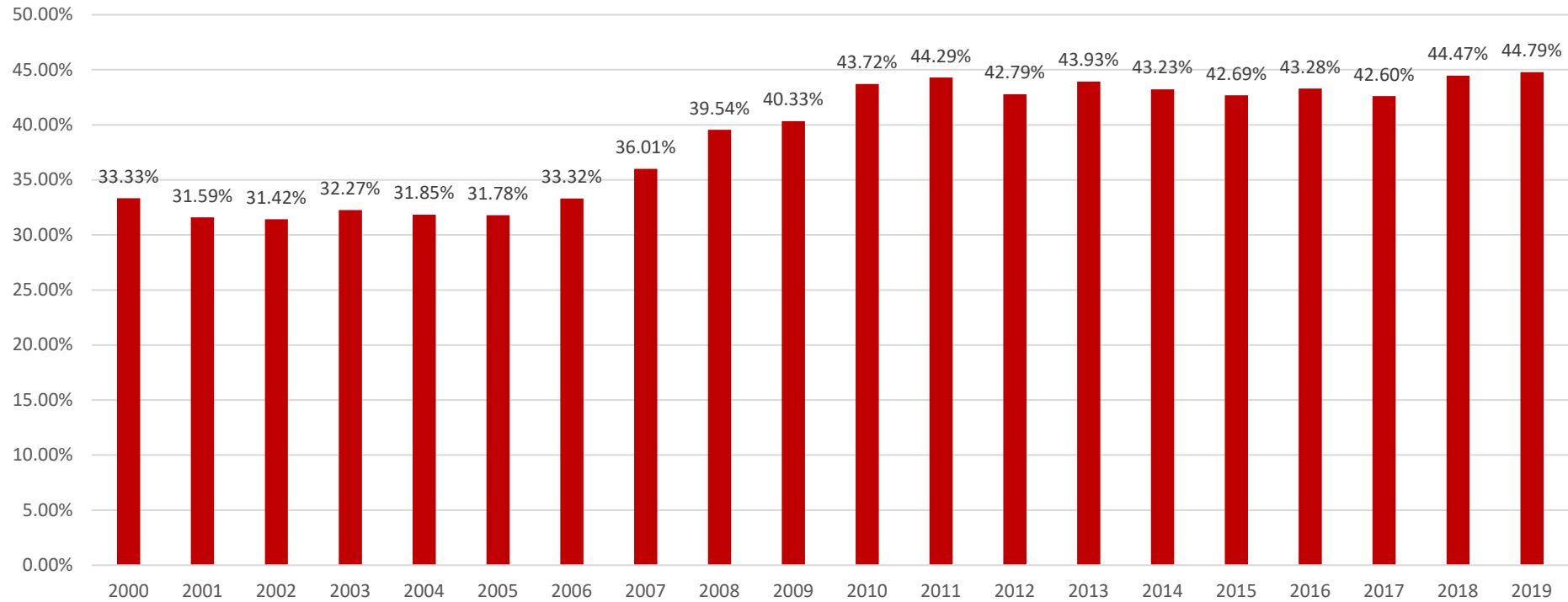

F1 and F2 Commitments: Percent of Terms Imposed at Bottom and Top of Range, 2000-2019*



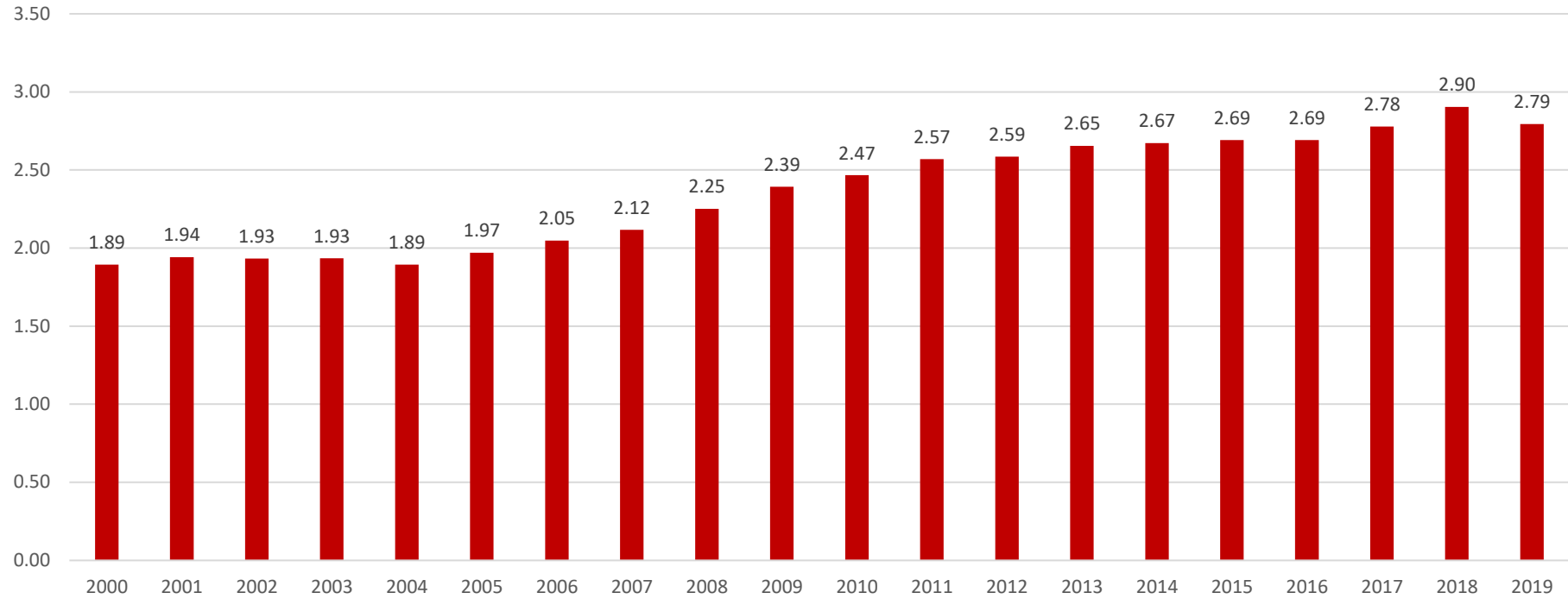
*Post SB2 F1 and F2 commitments, excluding commitments with time imposed consecutively across counts or offenses.

Percent of Commitments with Consecutive Terms Imposed, 2000-2019*



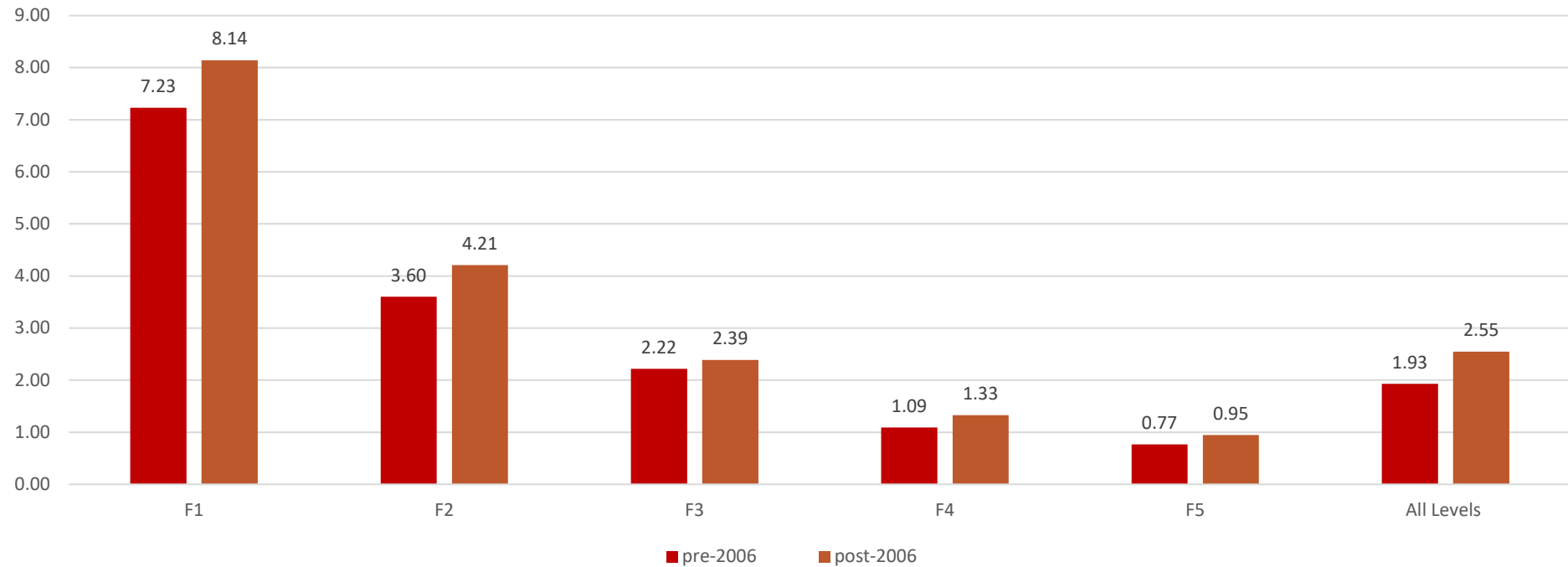
*Post SB2 F1-F5 commitments with 2 or more offenses.

Average Aggregate Term Imposed (in years) among All Felony Levels, 2000-2019*



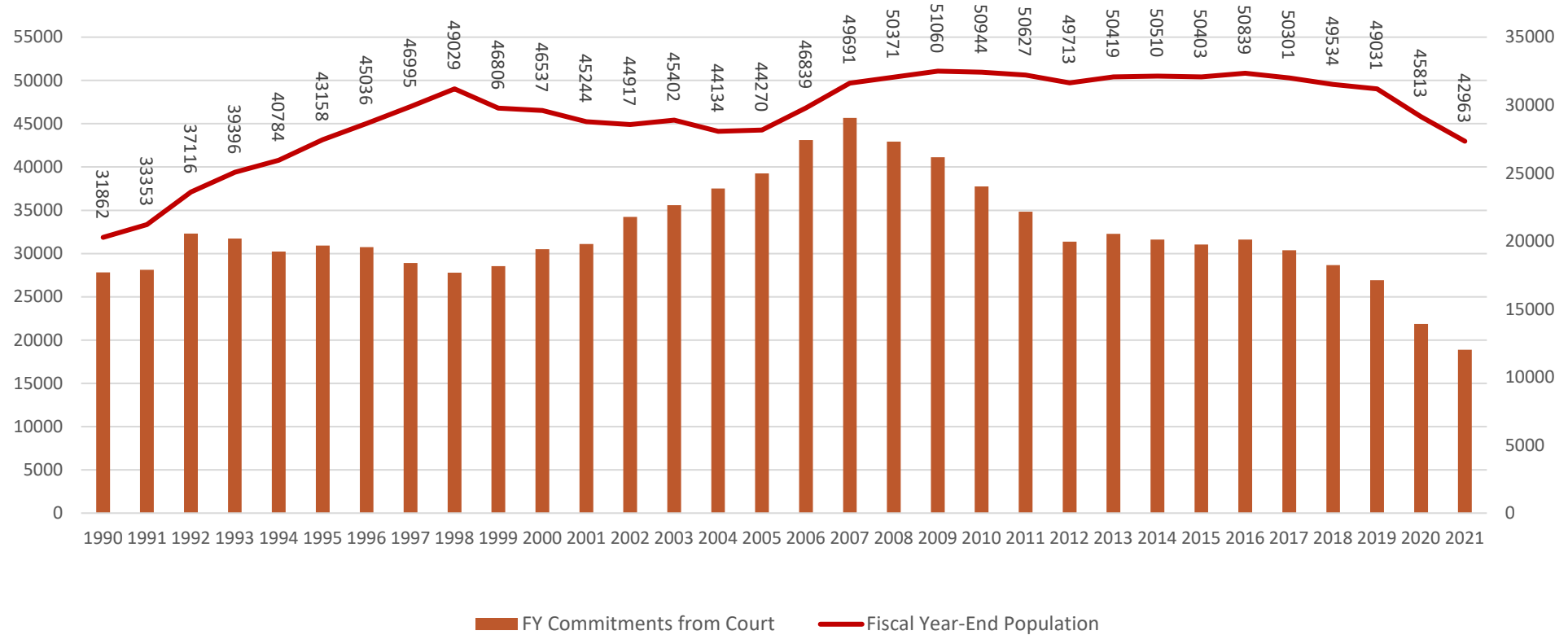
*Post SB2 F1-F5 commitments, excluding gun spec and enhancement time.

Average Aggregate Term Imposed (in years) among All Felony Levels, before and after 2006*

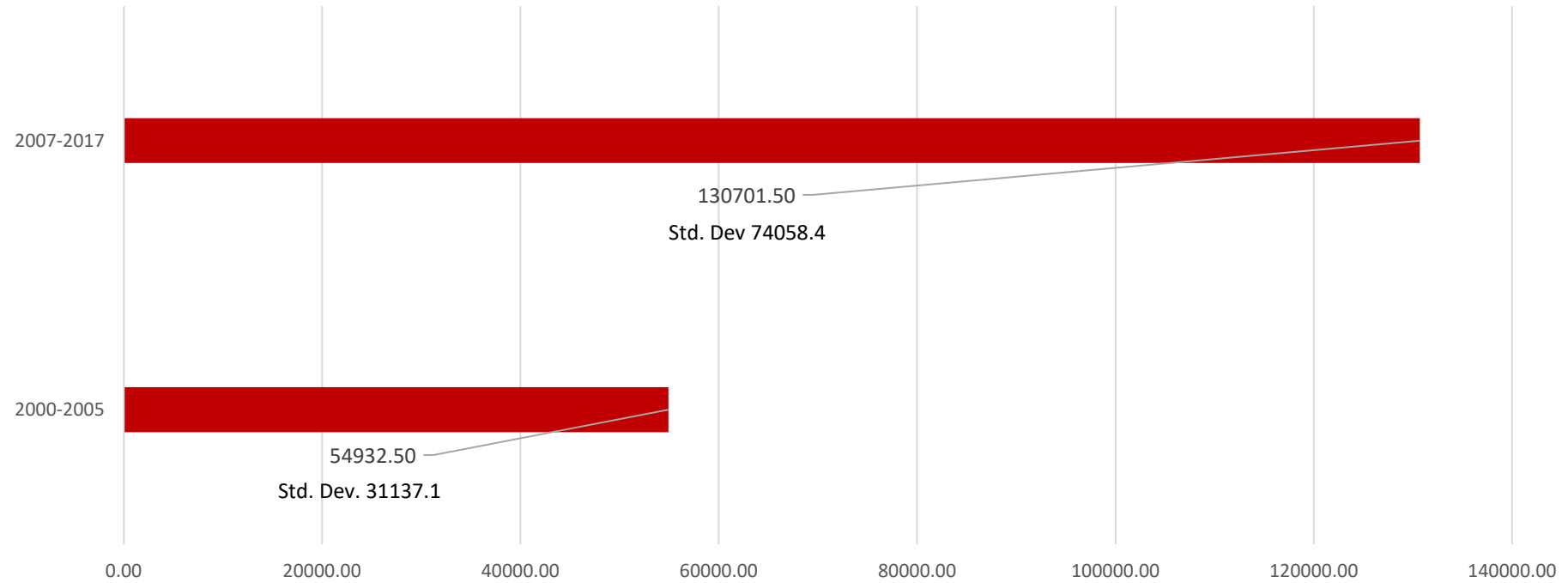
