
ENTRY

This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Upon consideration of Athens County Court of Common Pleas motions to dismiss and to have relator declared a vexatious litigator pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 14.5(B) [current rule S.Ct.Prac.R. 4.03(B)], and the motion to dismiss of Athens County Court of Common Pleas, it is ordered by the court that the motions to dismiss are granted and the motion to declare relator a vexatious litigator is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed and Cindy Johnson, a.k.a. Cinseree Johnson, is found to be a vexatious litigator under S.Ct.Prac.R. 14.5(B) [current rule S.Ct.Prac.R. 4.03(B)].

It is ordered by the Court that Cindy Johnson, a.k.a. Cinseree Johnson is prohibited from continuing or instituting legal proceedings in this Court without first obtaining leave. Any request for leave shall be submitted to the Clerk of this Court for the Court's review.

Upon consideration of relator's motions to strike the motion to dismiss and motion to declare relator a vexatious litigator, for default judgment, and to strike the appearance of Judge Michael Ward and Judge Alan Goldsberry, it is ordered by the court that the motions are denied.
