2020-1326	Beachwood City School District Bd. of Education v. Warrensville Heights City School District Bd. of Education	OPEN	01-22-2021	Proposition of Law I: R.C. 3311.06 and O.A.C. Chapter 3301-89 require the Ohio Board of Education to receive and approve any negotiated agreement related to a school district's request to transfer territory following a city's annexation of property, regardless of whether the proposed agreement involves the physical transfer of territory or just tax revenues. I. The plain language of R.C. 3311.06 required the Ohio Board of Education to approve the proposed agreement before it could become binding. II. The plain language of O.A.C. Chapter 3301-89 confirms that the Ohio Board of Education needed to approve the proposed agreement. Proposition of Law II: R.C. 5705.41 and 5705.412 apply to agreements to transfer tax revenues between school districts. Proposition of Law III: R.C. Chapter 2744 provides immunity from tort claims arising from a school district's negotiation of tax revenue-sharing agreements.
